TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of The Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill withdraws its Notice of Intention to designate 16-18 Lorne Avenue (the William Trench House), including land and building, as a property of cultural heritage value or interest under Part IV, section 29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18, as amended.

At its meeting held July 9, 2019, Council passed the following resolution:

That Council withdraw the notice of intention to designate the property at 16-18 Lorne Avenue, Richmond Hill (William Trench House) under part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, upon the owners of the lands serving a notice of withdrawal on the City Clerk of the City of Richmond Hill and the Conservation Review Board (File No. CRB 1707), City staff shall immediately withdraw the notice of intention to designate the subject property by causing a notice of withdrawal to be served on the owner of the property and on the Trust; and to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality;

That the property at 16-18 Lorne Avenue be removed from the City of Richmond Hill Inventory of Cultural Heritage Resources.
