Please be advised that the following Notice of Intention to repeal a Designated By-law #52-81 is being published for 3 successive weeks and served on the owner of the subject property:

Notice of Intention to Repeal Bylaw No. 52-81

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Nanticoke intends to repeal bylaw No. 52-81 being a bylaw to designate the property known as the McMichael-Muzzin residence located at Lot 9, Concession 6 of the former Township of Townsend, now in the City of Nanticoke, Region of Haldimand-Norfolk, pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980.

The purpose of repealing this bylaw is to allow a severance and the conveyance of a portion of the above mentioned property being more particularly described as Part 1 of Reference Plan 37R-2868. This conveyance will go to the abutting properties.

It is intended that a subsequent bylaw will redesignate the Mc-Michael-Muzzin residence located on the property more particularly described as Part 2 of Reference Plan 37R-2826.

Notice of objection to the repealing bylaw shall be served on the Clerk, setting out the reasons for objection and all relevant facts within thirty (30) days of the date of this publication.
