THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SCUGOG BY-LAW NUMBER 82-86

BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PALMER MEMORIAL PARK AT THE SOUTH/EAST CORNER OF WATER & QUEEN STS. AS BEING OF HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Scugog has received a request from the Chiropractic Association to designate Palmer Park in the Hamlet of Port Perry as being of Historical and Architectural importance;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Scugog deems it desirable to designate the said site;

AND WHEREAS Council's intentions to so designate has been duly advertised with no objection thereto;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SCUGOG Enacts As Follows:

- That Palmer Memorial Park located at the south/east corner of Water & Queen Sts. in Port Perry, more particularly described as part of Lots 120 & 121, Plan H-50020, be hereby designated as being of Historical importance.
- 2. The purpose of the designation is as follows:

Palmer Memorial Park, dedicated by the Council of the Village of Port Perry in 1958, containing a statute to honor the memory of Daniel David Palmer, the discoverer and founder of Chiropractic. The site is to be preserved for the use and enjoyment of the citizens of Scugog.

3. This By-Law shall come into full force and effect on the date of passing.

Read a First, Second and Third time and finally passed this 3rd day of November, 1986.
