BY-LAW NO. 80-1

of the

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COLLINGWOOD

Being a by-law to designate the properties known as:

1. 167 Minnesota Street
2. 242 Third Street
3. 200 Oak Street

as properties of architectural and historical value or interest.

AND WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest;

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to designate certain properties within the Municipality was served on the owners of the properties and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation on the 10th day of December, 1979 and was published in the Enterprise Bulletin on December 5th, 12th and 19th, 1979;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designations have been served on the Clerk of the Town of Collingwood;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COLLINGWOOD ENACTS as follows:


1. There are designated as being of historical or architectural value or interest the following properties in the Town of Collingwood:
 - a) 167 Minnesota Street - architectural designation
 - b) 242 Third Street - architectural designation
 - c) 200 Oak Street - historical and architectural designation

All as more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto attached.

2. The Town Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law and the reasons for designation to be registered against the properties described in Schedule "A" hereto in the land registry office at Barrie, Ontario.
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owners of the properties described in Schedule "A" hereto and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the Enterprise-Bulletin once for each of three consecutive weeks.
4. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on its final passing.

THAT this by-law be introduced, read and referred to the Committee of the Whole for study this 14th day of January, 1980.

All and singular those parcels or tracts of land and premises situated, lying and being in the Town of Collingwood, in the County of Simcoe and Province of Ontario and being composed of:

1. 167 Minnesota Street West, Plan 282, Lots 22, 25 and 26, North-East Part of Lot 27 and Part Lot 28 on the east side of Minnesota Street as shown on the amended McMaster Plan
2. 242 Third Street, Plan 469, Lot 3 and Lot 5, South Side of Third Street
3. 200 Oak Street, Plan 73, Lots 31, 32 and 33, on the West Side of Oak Street as shown on the Smith Plan
