Being a by-law to designate the properties known as:

- 224 Minnesota Street
- 375 Third Street 199 Third Street 2.
- 3.
- 4. 227 Minnesota Street
- 5. 75 Ontario Street
- 6. Temple Building, Hurontario Street

as properties of architectural and historical value or interest.

AND WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest;

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to designate certain properties within the Municipality was served on the owners of the properties and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation of the 27th day of April, 1983 and was published in the Enterprise Bulletin on April 27th, May 4th and May 11th, 1983;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designations have been served on the Clerk of the Town of Collingwood;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COLLINGWOOD ENACTS as follows:

- There are designated as being of historical or architectural value or interest the following properties in the Town of Collingwood:
  - 224 Minnesota Street
  - 375 Third Street b)
  - 199 Third Street
  - al 227 Minnesota Street
  - 75 Ontario Street e.)
  - Temple Building, Hurontario Street f)

All as more particularly described in Schedule "A"-"B"-"C"-"D"-"E" & "F" attached hereto.

- The Town Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law and the reasons for designation to be registered against the properties described in Schedule "A"-"B"-"C"-"D"-"E" & "F" hereto in the land registry office at Barrie, Ontario.
- The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owners of the properties described in Schedule "A"-"B"-"C"-"D"-"E" & "F" hereto and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the Enterprise-Bulletin once for each of three consecutive weeks.
- This by-law shall come into force and take effect on its final passing.

## SCHEDULE "A"

### 224 Minnesota Street

Those lands and premises located in the Town of Collingwood, in the County of Simcoe and being composed of Part Block "B", Plan 144 for the said County and Part of Lot 43, Concession 8, in the Town of Collingwood (formerly in the Township of Nottawasaga) more particularly described as follows:-

PREMISING that the Westerly limit of the Canadian National Railway right-of-way has a bearing of North 30 degrees 36 minutes 45 seconds West and relating all bearings herein thereto;
