Please be advised that on September 4, 2019, the Coordinator, Cultural Heritage Planning within the Department of Development Services of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener granted the following approval in accordance with By-law 2009-89, being a by-law to delegate certain authority of Council to consent to permits for the alteration of property designated under Part IV and V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*:

"Pursuant to Section 33 of the Ontario Heritage Act, Heritage Permit Application HPA-2019-IV-017 is approved to permit the construction of a swimming pool and fence on the property municipally addressed as 920 Orr Court, in accordance with the plans and supplementary information submitted with the application, and subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the final building permit drawings be reviewed and heritage clearance provided by Heritage Planning staff prior to the issuance of a building permit; and
- 2. That a licensed consultant archaeologist be retained to monitor excavation works as it relates to the installation of a swimming pool to the satisfaction of the Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Sport."
