BY-LAW NUMBER 544/84

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 415/78

WHEREAS THE INCORRECT NAME OF "FORWARD" WAS MADE REFERENCE TO IN THE BODY OF BY-LAW NUMBER 451/78

AND WHEREAS IT IS NOW DESIRABLE TO CORRECT THE REFERENCES MADE TO "FORWARD", NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Village of Bath enacts as follows:

1. Delete the name "FORWARD" referred to in paragraph two, line three, of By-Law number 415/78, and insert the name "ISAAC HOUGH".

Paragraph two will now read as follows:

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Bath has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as "Building once owned by ISAAC HOUGH", in Concession 1, Part Lot 13, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

2. Delete the name "FORWARDS" referred to in paragraph four, (i), line three of By-Law number 415/78, and insert the name "ISAAC HOUGH".

Paragraph four (i) will now read as follows:

i) There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as "Building once owned by ISAAC HOUGH", in Concession 1, part Lot 13.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME, AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 13th day of August 1984.
