BY-LAW NUMBER 130-87 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF STRATFORD

BEING a by-law to designate the real property known municipally as the Huron Street Bridge as being of architectural and historical value or interest.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural and historical value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Stratford has consulted with its Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Stratford has caused to be served upon The Ontario Heritage Foundation and the owners of the property known as the Huron Street Bridge notice of its intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused general circulation in the City of Stratford by publication of the notice of intention in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Stratford ENACTS as follows:

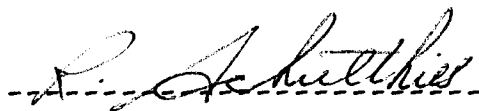
1. There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as the Huron Street Bridge in the City of Stratford for the reasons described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
2. The Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper land registry office which property is legally described in Schedule "B" attached hereto.
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on The Ontario Heritage Foundation and the owner of the property and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the Stratford Beacon Herald being a paper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME AND

FINALLY PASSED this 27th day of July, A.D. 1987.

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SCHEDULE 'A'

Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The Huron Street Bridge is historically significant because it is the only example of its kind in Stratford and one of the few remaining stone bridges in Ontario. It was designed in 1885 by local architect Alexander Hepburn, and built by contractor, A. Corrie. Since the existing stone work is significant to our heritage, designation of this structure will include all of the following features: the stone side walls; solid railings; the abutments; the stone work beneath the arches; and the sandstone details.

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SCHEDULE "B"

The old stone bridge crossing the Avon River at the eastern extremity of Huron Street and connected to the westerly limit of Ontario Street, as shown on Plan 20, City of Stratford, County of Perth.
