BY-LAW NUMBER 85-166

To designate the property known as Shiloh Apostolic Church of Jesus Christ as being architecturally and historically of value or interest under the Ontario Heritage Act.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Caledon has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as Shiloh Apostolic Church of Jesus Christ in part of the West Half of Lot 2, Concession 2, Town of Caledon, Regional Municipality of Peel, formerly in the Township of Albion, County of Peel, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;


THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the Town of Caledon enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as "Shiloh Apostolic Church of Jesus Church", formerly St. Marks Anglican Church, Sandhill, Ontario, more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached, and comprising 0.15 acres more or less.
2. The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" attached hereto in the proper registry office.
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

SCHEDULE "A"

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Town of Caledon, in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Township of Albion, in the County of Peel) and Province of Ontario, containing by admeasurement 0.15 of an acre, more or less, and being composed of a part of the westerly half of Lot Number 11 in the First Concession of the said Town of Caledon, and which may be more particularly described as follows, that is to say:-

COMMENCING at a point on the north-westerly limit of the present allowance for road between Lots Number 10 and 11 in the said First Concession and distant 574.84 feet north-easterly from the southerly angle of the said Lot Number 11;

THENCE NORTH forty-five degrees fifteen minutes east ($N 45^{\circ} 15' E$) along the said north-westerly limit of allowance for road eighty feet (80') to a stake;

THENCE NORTH forty-four degrees west ($N 44^{\circ} W$) parallel to the front of the said Lot Number 11 eighty feet (80') to a stake;

THENCE SOUTH forty-five degrees fifteen minutes west ($S 45^{\circ} 15' W$) parallel to the said north-westerly limit of allowance for road eighty feet (80') to a stake;

THENCE SOUTH forty-four degrees east ($S 44^{\circ} E$) parallel to the said front eighty feet (80') more or less to the place of beginning.
