NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO DESIGNATION BY-LAW 2018-104, "A by-law to designate the Glassco House at 338 Spruce Street as a property of cultural heritage value or interest"

On April 12, 2021, Oakville Town Council resolved to amend Heritage Designation By-law 2018-104, "A by-law to designate the Glassco House at 338 Spruce Street as a property of cultural heritage value or interest" for the following property under Section 30.1 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18, as amended:

Glassco House 340 Spruce Street Oakville, Ontario

Purpose and Effect of Proposed Amendment

The proposed amendment of By-law 2018-104, "A by-law to designate the Glassco House at 338 Spruce Street as a property of cultural heritage value or interest" is to correct the property's legal description.

The following is the amended Legal Description:

In the Town of Oakville in the Regional Municipality of Halton, the property description is as follows:

Glassco House

340 Spruce Street

Part Lot 12 Plan 121; Lot 13 Plan 121, as in 758044; save and accept Lot 14 Plan 121; Town of Oakville
