The Heritage Advisory Committee at its meeting on April 11, 2023 considered a Corporate Report dated March 3, 2023 regarding the above-noted property. It was determined by the Heritage Advisory Committee to designate the heritage building and the following recommendation was subsequently adopted by Council under Council Resolution 0099-2023 at its meeting held on April 19, 2023:

HAC-0015-2023

- That the property at 1141 Clarkson Road North (Ward 2) be designated under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act for its associative and contextual value and that the appropriate City officials be authorized and directed to take the necessary action to give effect thereto as outlined in the report dated March 3, 2023 from the Commissioner of Community Services.
- That the Heritage Advisory Committee request a Motion be brought forth to Council to recommend the designation of the heritage building at 1141 Clarkson Road North (Ward 2) and oppose the demolition application submitted by the new owners.

Notice of Intention to Pass a By-Law to Designate 1141 Clarkson Road North to be of Cultural Heritage Value and Interest Pursuant to the Provisions of the *Ontario Heritage Act* (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.18)

Take Notice that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga intends to pass a by-law under Section 29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.18, to designate the lands and premises located at 1141 Clarkson Road North in the City of Mississauga, in the Province of Ontario as of April 19, 2023 (Council Resolution 0099-2023).

1141 Clarkson Road North is a two-storey house on the east side of Clarkson Road North, north of the Canadian National railway tracks.

Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest

The property has associative value because it has direct associations with Henry Shook Clarkson, son of Clarkson founder Warren Clarkson. Clarkson is a founding village of Mississauga.

The property has contextual value because it is physically, functionally, visually and historically linked to the other Clarkson homes/businesses in the area on Clarkson Road North and Feeley Court.

Description of Heritage Attributes

- Size and massing of the Clarkson portion of the house, including its Ontario Gothic shape and form with gable, pointed gable window and symmetrically placed sash windows on the south face
- Location of the house on Clarkson Road North and its relationship to the William Clarkson House, Edith Clarkson House and Clarkson General Store
- Setback of the house from Clarkson Road
- Visibility from Clarkson Road
