





Notice of Intention to Designate

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge intends to designate the exterior of the following property for architectural and historical significance under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Ch.0.18.

288 Main Street East

Built in 1862 this house dates from an early period in the development of the city. This granite house is a well preserved and representative example of a method of construction now rarely used. It is a fine example of a style of modest Georgian cottage once popular in this area. This cottage predates its neighbours both in age and style and through adding diversity to the area also adds visual richness.

ANY PERSON MAY, within thirty days of this publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Cambridge, notice of his objection and all relevant facts. If such a notice is received the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
