Notice of Intention to Designate

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge intends to designate the exterior of the following property for its architectural and historical significance under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Ch.0.18.

81 Water Street South

This Italianate residence was constructed circa 1851 by James Dalglish. It later became the residence of Dr. T. W. Vardon who served as Mayor of Galt from 1895 - 98. James Dalglish was one of the first architect builders to work in Galt. In his memorial it was stated that he constructed many of the best buildings of the town.

ANY PERSON MAY, within thirty days of this publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Cambridge, notice of his objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a notice is received the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
