TAKE NOTICE that the Township of King Council, on February 6, 2023, refused the Owner's request and application to repeal Designation By-law 2013-141 under Section 32(1) of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, for the property known as Second King Baptist Church located at 5010 - 18th Sideroad which has been designated under Section 29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990.

AND TAKE NOTICE that if the Owner of the property objects to Council's decision, the owner may appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal (the "OLT") by giving the OLT and the Township Clerk, within 30 days after receipt of this notice, that being no later than March 17th, 2023, a notice of appeal (Appeal Form A1) setting out the objection to the decision and the reasons in support of the objection, accompanied by the fee charged by the OLT as specified on their website at www.olt.gov.on.ca.
