NOTICE OF REPEALING BY-LAW

On September 11, 2023, Oakville Town Council resolved to pass By-law 2023-125, a By-law to repeal By-law 1994-175 being 'a by-law to designate 141 Bronte Road as a property of historical and architectural value and interest' under Section 32 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18, as amended.

Property Description:

Old Church of the Epiphany 141 Bronte Road

Parcel 74-1, Section M-7, being Lot 74, Plan M-7, Town of Oakville, Regional Municipality of Halton, Plan BA-147 under the Boundaries Act

In accordance with s.32 (5) of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, any person who objects to the by-law may appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal by giving the Tribunal and the clerk of the municipality, within 30 days after the date of publication on the town's website, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the by-law and the reasons in support of the objection, accompanied by the fee charged by the Tribunal. The last date to appeal this by-law is October 16, 2023.

A by-law to repeal By-law 1994-175 - A by-law to designate 141 Bronte Road as a property of historical and architectural value and interest

WHEREAS subsection 32 (1) of the *Ontario Heritage Act* permits an owner of property designated under this Part to apply to the council of the municipality in which the property is situate to repeal the by-law or part thereof designating the property;


AND WHEREAS after consultation with its municipal heritage committee, Oakville Town Council has considered the application and consented to the application to repeal By-law 1994-175;

- That the Town Solicitor be authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property legally described in Schedule "A" at the Land Registry Office and served on the property owner and on the Ontario Heritage Trust.


