Being a by-law to repeal By-law No. 1781(1984)
and to dedesignate the property identified as
256 Centre Street, Town of Wingham

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wingham enacted By-law No. 1781(1984) under which 256 Centre Street, Town of Wingham was designated as being of historical value in the community;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of North Huron has agreed with the request of the current owners to have the property dedesignated as having historical value within the Ward of Wingham, Township of North Huron;
