At the regular meeting on December 6, 2022, Council approved Clause 3i of Report Number 05: Received from Heritage Kingston with respect to Application for Ontario Heritage Act Approval – 965 Sydenham Road:

That alterations to the property at 965 Sydenham Road be approved in accordance with details described in the application (P18-091-2022), which was deemed complete on September 22, 2022 with said alterations to include the installation of a two-sided free-standing sign; and

That the approval of the application be subject to the following conditions:

1. A Building/Sign Permit shall be obtained, as necessary;
2. Heritage Planning staff shall be circulated the drawings and design specifications tied to the Building Permit application for review and approval to ensure consistency with the scope of the Heritage Permit sought by this application;
3. An Encroachment Permit and/or Temporary Access Permit shall be obtained, as necessary;
4. Utility locates shall be obtained prior to any digging; and

5. Any minor deviations from the submitted plans, which meet the intent of this approval and does not further impact the heritage attributes of the property, shall be delegated to the Director of Heritage Services for review and approval.
