At the regular meeting on August 9, 2022, Council approved Clause 1ii of Report Number 76: Received from Heritage Kingston with respect to Application for Ontario Heritage Act Approval – 27 Princess Street:

That alterations to the property at 27 Princess Street, be approved in accordance with details described in the application (P18-058-2022), which was deemed completed on May 19, 2022 with said alterations to include:

 Installation of four decals on two exterior windows facing Princess Street and two facing Ontario Street at street level with leaf imprints in four pale shades of grey, green, blue and red, being approximately 1.9 metres wide by 1.7 metres tall; and

That the approval of the alterations be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. An Encroachment Permit shall be obtained, as necessary;
- 2. A Building Permit shall be obtained, as necessary;
- Heritage Planning staff shall be circulated the drawings and design specifications tied to the Building Permit application for review and approval to ensure consistency with the scope of the Heritage Permit sought by this application; and

4. Any minor deviations from the submitted plans, which meet the intent of this approval and does not further impact the heritage attributes of the property, shall be delegated to the Director of Heritage Services for review and approval.
