This is to advise you that Ottawa City Council, at its meeting of November 22, 2023, approved the following recommendation(s) in respect of the above-noted item:

- Approve the application to alter the former Hintonburg Pumping Station at 5
 Onigam Street, according to plans submitted by CSW dated August 2023,
 conditional upon:
 - a. Development and implementation of an interpretation strategy as part of the overall project
- 2. Direct staff to prepare an amendment to the designation by-law (280-87) to reflect the current heritage value of the Hintonburg Pumping Station.
- 3. Delegate the authority for minor design changes to the General Manager, Planning, Real Estate and Economic Development Department.
- 4. Approve the issuance of the heritage permits for each application with a threeyear expiry date from the date of issuance unless otherwise extended by Council.
