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THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF DESERONTO

BY-LAW NUMBER 11-80

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS 112 FOURTH STREET (UNITED CHURCH) AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE.

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act 1974 authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Deseronto deems the aforesaid real property to be of architectural and historical value; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Deseronto has published a 'Notice of Intention to Designate' the aforesaid real property in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Town Clerk;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Deseronto ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That the real property known as the United Church at 112 Fourth Street (Block C, Lot 6 & 7, Plan 162) Deseronto, Ontario is hereby designated as being of architectural and historical value.
- 2. That the municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described above in the Hastings County Land Registry Office.
- 3. That the Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.
