THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DOURO

BY-LAW NUMBER 1986-33

Being a By-law to Designate the property known Municipally as Part of Lot 5, Concession 4, Township of Douro (St. Joseph's Cemetery, Douro Post Office, Douro, Ontario) as being of Historical Value or Interest.

WHEREAS section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Douro has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as St. Joseph's Cemetery at the Hamlet of Douro, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Township of Douro enacts as follows:

1. THAT the aforesaid real property, being a portion of St. Joseph's Cemetery located in the Hamlet of Douro and described as follows:

"the Westerly 165' of the Northerly 264'  
of Lot 5, Concession 4 for the said  
Township of Douro",

be designated historical in accordance with The Ontario Heritage Act, 1980.

2. THAT the Reeve and the Clerk be and are hereby directed to sign this By-law to effect same and are directed to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 16TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, A.D., 1986.
