**For:** Repair and restore a stained-glass window on the West side of the church. The stained-glass window titled *Suffer the Children to Come Unto Me* will be removed, restored, and reinstated. The restoration of the glass includes fixing and repainting the broken panes. The wood window frame restoration involves exterior and interior work. Exterior work includes the fabrication and installation of new wood frames and sashes to match the existing configuration and interior work includes dutchman repairs to the wood sill. All wood is to be primed and painted.

Additional work includes the restoration of the Gethsemane stained glass window on the east side of the church that was recently vandalized. The repair technique for this window will follow the same approach used for the west side window.


