TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of the Corporation of the City of Windsor intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address, as a property of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act:

Property

986 Ouellette Avenue (Part Lots 19, 20 and 21, Block 3, Plan 256)
known as the Border Masonic Temple

Reasons for Designation

- Architectural** - entire Ouellette Avenue and Erie Street elevations;
- ornamental brick and stone work;
- Historical** - association with respected local architect, James Carlisle Pennington;
- Ouellette Avenue landmark.

Any person may, within thirty days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Windsor notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Windsor shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
