TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township  
of Yarmouth intends to designate the property, including lands  
and buildings, at the following municipal address as a property  
of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV  
of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S. O. Chapter 122.

FORGE AND ANVIL, PLAN 48, PART LOT 2, MAIN STREET, NORTH SIDE, ..  
SPARTA, IN THE TOWNSHIP OF YARMOUTH IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO.

The Forge and Anvil, built in 1827 is recommended for designation  
for architectural reasons. Historically, the building served as a  
blacksmith shop from 1837 until the 1940's and was then conveyed to  
the Sparta Sorosis Women's Institute.

This building has served as a civic symbol for over 140 years, and  
epitomizes and reflects the nature of the surrounding district.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a  
statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts  
may be served on the Clerk of the Township of Yarmouth before the  
8th day of November, 1978.
