## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT 566 KINGSTON ROAD W.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Ajax intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings at 566 Kingston Road West as a property of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0. 18.

Municipal Address: 566 Kingston Rd W., Part Lot 4, Plan 11, Town of Ajax, Region of Durham, Province of Ontario

## Reason for Designation:

This house is a storey-and-half, centre hall plan, late Victorian Ontario vernacular, with a summer kitchen "tail" and a later glassed-in porch. The structure has been changed and adapted from an earlier single storey rectangular structure. There are tablet windows in the front gable. The original portion of the house has timber framing. The original clapboard and beaded corner boards are in excellent condition. This house is part of a row of nine 19th century house, two of which are already designated, that are still largely recognizable in their original or at least 19th century form.

Any person may, within thirty days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Ajax notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Ajax will refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.

THE LAST DAY FOR FILING OBJECTIONS IS October 31, 1997.
