Pursuant to provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act, RSO 1990 as amended, 2002 c. 18 Schedule F S. 2(18), we are providing notification to the Ontario Heritage Foundation that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg passed a resolution on July 26, 2004 to approve an application for a demolition permit to demolish the Salmoni Building at 252 Dalhousie Street, Part Lots 7 & 8, Plan 1, west side of Dalhousie Street in the Town of Amherstburg.

As you are likely aware Bylaw 1485 was passed by the Town on July 25, 1977 designating the above property as being of historical and architectural value to the Town of Amherstburg.
