### **NOTICE OF INTENT TO DESIGNATE**

**TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg intends to designate the property including the lands and building at the following municipal address as property of historical and architectural value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act R.S.O. 1990, c.0.18**

669 Front Road North  
Amherstburg, Ontario**

### **REASON FOR DESIGNATION OF 669 FRONT ROAD NORTH**

#### **Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest:**

The Thomas Ouellette Carriage House heritage value lies in it being an example of "Gothic Revival post and beam barn construction as can be seen in the architectural details at the verge boards, window brackets and gable shape. The building remains in its original form. This building was constructed in 1881 by Thomas Ouellette as part of the adjacent property known as the Thomas Ouellette House.

The building's cultural heritage value lies in its association with its original owner Thomas Ouellette, a successful lumber merchant from a well known Essex County family.

#### **Description of Heritage Attributes:**

Key exterior attributes that embody the heritage value of the Thomas Ouellette Carriage House include:

- The prominent siting of the building on the lot.
- The decorative wooden ornaments typical to the Gothic Revival Style
- The two prominent gothic gables on the front elevation.

**ANY PERSON** may, before March 29, 2007 send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Amherstburg notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of reasons for the objection and relevant facts. If such a notice of objection is received, The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg will refer the matter to the Conservation review board for a hearing.
