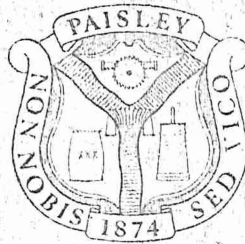

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Paisley, on the 19th. day of July 1976 decided to designate the land and building municipally known as the Fisher's Mill on the Teeswater River; as a property of historical and architectural value or interest under the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The Grist Mill, Saw Mill and Dam on the Teeswater River, commonly known as Fisher's Mill which dates from 1855 is recommended or designation for architectural reasons as the Grist Mill is a good example of an Ontario Mill structure, using a rubble stone rectangular base and timber framing above. Historically the site of the mills is important as Paisley first industry was founded near the present location of the Grist Mill. The mills and dam offer an important scenic vista and their preservation is important in retaining Paisley's heritage.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served in writing, on the Clerk, within 30 days of the 22nd. day of July 1976.
