This is to advise that Innisfil Council intends to amend Heritage Designation By-law 090-09 for the property municipally known as 1629 3rd Line, Town of Innisfil, County of Simcoe, pursuant to Section 30.1(2) of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990.

Purpose and Effect of Proposed Amendment

The purpose of amending Heritage Designation By-law 090-09 is to correct the legal description of the property by removing references to Part 2 on Registered Plan 51R-10763, which was severed from the property.

The amended legal description of By-law 090-09 would become **North Part Lot 20, Concession 2, Reference Plan 51R-10763, Parts 1, 3 and 4, Town of Innisfil, County of Simcoe.**

Notice of Objection
