NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Haldimand intends to designate the property, including land and buildings, at the following municipal address as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1980, S.O. Chapter 337.

Cottonwood Mansion, West Half of Lot 1, Concession 4, in the former Township of Rainham, now in the Town of Haldimand, in The Regional Municipality of Haldimand-Norfolk, in the Province of Ontario.

Reasons for Proposed Designation:

Built by William Holmes approximately 1860 on the farm originally established by his father-in-law, Christian Hoover, in 1811. It is one of the few remaining examples of rural mansions of the period. It contains 16 rooms - including 5 bedrooms, a music room and a Widow' Walk.

Architectural Items for Designation:

Exterior North West and South elevations including brickwork, windows, shutters, front door and entablature details. Interior - ceiling medallions and cornice details. Winding staircase with decorative oak leaf design. Marble fireplace. Floor detail and interior doors and hardware.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Town of Haldimand before the 16th day of March, 1989.
