

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE



Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, on the 23rd day of September, 1982, decided to designate the lands and buildings known municipally as No.20 (22) Front Street West as a property of architectural value or interest, under the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

Short Statement of Reasons for the Proposed Designation

No.20 (22) Front Street West (The Gowans Kent Building, now Film House) is recommended for designation for architectural reasons. Built in 1923, the Gowans Kent Building was designed by Architects MacVicar and Heriot, for Cassidy's Ltd., functioning as office, chinaware showroom and warehouse for thirty years. Classically influenced, the stone detailing of the facade is distinctive with four arched openings inset with finely crafted metal entrances and display windows. The mouldings, keystones, spandrels and cornice are other features that contribute to the significance of this building in context with the scale and materials of the Dominion Public Building and Union Station on Front Street West.

Notice of Objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of the 12th of October, 1982. (File 2352).
