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THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GODERICH
BY-LAW NO. 5 OF 1992

A by-law to designate property of architectural and/or historical significance as a Heritage Property under the terms of Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1980, R.S.O., Chapter 337.

WHEREAS the Ontario Heritage Act, 1980, authorizes Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all the buildings and structures thereon to be of architectural and/or historical significance;


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Goderich has cause to be served upon the owner of the land and premise of The Former Bank of Canada Building, 46 West Street, Goderich, Ontario and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation Notice of Intention to Designate this real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in a newspaper having a general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the said proposed designation has been served upon the Clerk of the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GODERICH ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. All real property, described as The Former Bank of Canada Building, 46 West Street, Goderich, Ontario is designated as being of architectural and/or historical significance.
2. The Town Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described as The Former Bank of Canada Building, 46 West Street, Goderich, Ontario, in the proper land registry office.
3. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the property described as The Former Bank of Upper Canada Building, 46 West Street, Goderich, Ontario and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of this by-law to be published in a newspaper having a general circulation in the Town of Goderich.
