NOTICE OF DECISION

Take Notice that the Council of the Corporation of the  
City of Toronto on the 14th day of November, 1983, having  
considered the application for Consent to Demolish the building  
known municipally as No. 39 Davenport Road, and after giving  
consideration to the matter, decided:

(A) TO REFUSE THE APPLICATION TO DEMOLISH THE  
DESIGNATED PROPERTY AT 39 DAVENPORT ROAD  
(JESSE KETCHUM HALL) AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH  
SECTION 34 OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, PROHIBIT  
ANY WORK TO DEMOLISH OR REMOVE ANY BUILDING OR  
STRUCTURE ON THE PROPERTY FOR A PERIOD OF 180  
DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ITS DECISION.
