Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, on the 4th day of February, 1976, decided to designate the lands and buildings, known municipally as 56 Wellesley Street East, as a property of historical value or interest under The Contario Heritage Act, 1974, 1974 S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The Paul Kane House, 56 Wellesley Street East. The Paul Kane House is recommended for designation on historical grounds as the home of Paul Kane, Canada's foremost painter of the west and its native inhabitants.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of the 13th day of February, 1976. (Reference File 1116).
