BY-LAW NO. 20-1983

Being a by-law to designate the Romanik residence,
in the Township of Tuckersmith, of architectural
and historical value.

WHEREAS the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337,
Part IV authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact by-laws
to designate real property including all the building and structures
thereon to be of historic or architectural value and interest and;

WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Tuckersmith has caused
to be served upon the owner of the lands and premises known as the
Romanik residence, Part Lot 6, Concession 4, HRS, notice of intention
to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice
of intention to be published in a newspaper having general circulation
in the Municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks, and;

WHEREAS the reason for designation is that the Romanik residence
was built in the 1860's is an historically important example of
Georgian architecture, significant to the founding of the Township
of Tuckersmith and;

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the said proposed designation
has been served upon the Clerk of the Municipality.

THEREFORE the Corporation of the Township of Tuckersmith ENACTS
AS FOLLOWS:

1. The lands designated as being of architectural and historical value
that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situated and lying
and being in the Township of Tuckersmith, in the County of Huron,
and the Province of Ontario, and being composed of the main
residence on Lot 6, Concession 4, HRS, for the Township of
Tuckersmith.
2. That the Clerk be hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law
to be registered against a certain parcel or tract of land and
premises situated and lying and being in the Township of Tuckersmith,
in the County of Huron, and the Province of Ontario, and being
composed of Lot 6, Concession 4, HRS, in the Township of Tuckersmith.
3. That the Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law
to be served upon the owners of the aforesaid property and upon the
Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of this by-law to
be published in a newspaper having a general circulation in the
Township of Tuckersmith.
