THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FERGUS

BY-LAW NUMBER 3045

Being a By-law to designate 555 St. David Street North to be of historic or architectural value or interest.

WHEREAS on the advice of the Local Architectural Advisory Committee, Council has been advised to designate the lands attached hereto to be of historic or architectural value or interest pursuant to the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, c. 337;

AND WHEREAS the provisions of Section 29, Subsections (1), (2), (4) have been complied with and no notice of objection has been received by the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FERGUS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- The lands and premises described in Schedule "A" attached hereto are hereby 1. designated to be lands and buildings of historic or architectural value or interest.
- The reasons for the designations are as follows: 2.

The one and a half storey limestone house built on this property was built in 1879 for Georgina Young, for many years a hatmaker and seamstress in Fergus. A centrally placed entrance tower distinguishes this house from the conventional storey and a half bungalow that was popular in early Fergus. The tower extends above the plane of the roof to form a forwardly-thrusting dormer, which is flanked by a single roof-dormer on each side. The dormers feature round-headed windows and decorative verge boards. The eaves of the house are supported by elaborate wood brackets. The tower entrance is of generous proportions, and features a double-leaf door with a semi-circular top light.

This By-law shall be registered against the title of the lands described in Schedule 3. "A".

This By-law shall come into force and effect upon its final passing. 4.
