



Dear Sir/Madam:

Take notice the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Centre Wellington intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address as property of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990.

**189 Union Street East, former Town of Fergus**

Reasons for Designation:

The earliest date recorded for a residential occupancy at this location is 1873. However, the land on which this building stands was contiguous with the adjacent property at 290 St. David Street South, and it is thought that the two buildings originated in the same period of the 1850's. The oldest part of this building is constructed of uncoursed random ashlar identical with that used in the adjacent building. The present south façade is largely coursed ashlar from the late nineteenth century with more recent river stone rubble finish to the porch and the southwest corner. The variety of stone construction is representative of the type and method of similar buildings in the Fergus area.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Township of Centre Wellington before the 26<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1999.
