## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FERGUS

BY-LAW NUMBER 3044

Being a By-law to designate 203 St. Patrick Street East to be of historic or architectural value or interest.

WHEREAS on the advice of the Local Architectural Advisory Committee, Council has been advised to designate the lands attached hereto to be of historic or architectural value or interest pursuant to the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, c. 337;

AND WHEREAS the provisions of Section 29, Subsections (1), (2), (4) have been complied with and no notice of objection has been received by the Municipality.

## NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FERGUS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The lands and premises described in Schedule "A" attached hereto are hereby designated to be lands and buildings of historic or architectural value or interest.
- 2. The reasons for the designations are as follows:

This large two-storey house, built of locally quarried limestone was originally the residence of Rev. Enoch Barker, a minister of the Congregational Church in Fergus. The main part was built in 1870, and easterly wing and the bay window in the main section were added in 1873. A one-storey addition at the rear of the house is of later origin.

The formal appearance of this house derives from good design proportions, rather than elaborate detail or ornamentation. The double-leaf front door with round-ended side lights and top lights, and the bay window, are distinctive features of the house.

3. This By-law shall be registered against the title of the lands described in Schedule "A".

4. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon its final passing.
