THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF SAULT STE. MARIE

BY-LAW NO. 81-18

A by-law to designate the property known municipally as Precious Blood Cathedral at 778 Queen Street East, as being of architectural and historical value or interest.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest; and


WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Sault Ste. Marie has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises at 778 Queen Street East and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality for each of three consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Sault Ste. Marie ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as PRECIOUS BLOOD CATHEDRAL, 778 Queen Street East, more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto.

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the City of Sault Ste. Marie, in the District of Algoma, more particularly described as follows:

FIRSTLY:

That part of Park Lot 25, Concession 1, lying on the north side of Queen Street East, described as follows:

COMMENCING at the southeasterly angle of that part of Park Lot 25, north of Queen Street East;

THENCE westerly along the northerly limit of Queen Street East, a distance of 113.6 feet more or less to the southwest angle of the portion herein described;

THENCE northeasterly along the westerly limit of said Park Lot a distance of 386.2 feet to a point;

THENCE easterly and parallel to the northerly limit of Queen Street East, a distance of 113 feet more or less to a point in the easterly limit of said Park Lot;

THENCE southwesterly along the easterly limit of said Park Lot a distance of 386.2 feet more or less to the point of commencement.

SECONDLY:

That part of Park Lot 26, Concession 1, lying on the north side of Queen Street East, described as follows:

COMMENCING at the southeasterly angle of that part of Park Lot 26, north of Queen Street East;

THENCE westerly along the northerly limit of Queen Street East, a distance of 86.2 feet more or less to the southwest angle of the portion herein described;

THENCE northeasterly along the westerly limit of said Park Lot a distance of 387 feet to a point;

THENCE easterly and parallel to the northerly limit of Queen Street East, a distance of 85.2 feet more or less to a point in the easterly limit of said Park Lot;

THENCE southwesterly along the easterly limit of said Park Lot a distance of 386.7 feet more or less to the point of commencement, as shown on plan attached to Instrument # 40979.
