BY-LAW NO. 92-18

HISTORIC SITES: (L.5.2.7.) A by-law to designate the property at 943 Landslide Road as being of architectural or historic value or interest.

**WHEREAS** Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, c. 337 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest; and

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Sault Ste. Marie has caused to be served on the owners of the lands known as 943 Landslide Road and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality for each of three consecutive weeks; and

**WHEREAS** no objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;

**THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Sault Ste. Marie, pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act **ENACTS** as follows:

1. PROPERTY DESIGNATED

There is designated as being of architectural or historic value or interest, the property known as:

943 Landslide Road, more particularly described on Schedule "A" attached to this by-law.

2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This by-law takes effect on the date of its final passing.
