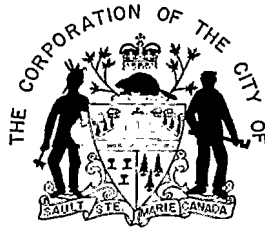

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Sault Ste. Marie intends to designate the property at the following municipal address as properties of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, chapter O.18.

**REASONS FOR PROPOSED DESIGNATION - 1186 QUEEN STREET EAST**

It is recommended that the Queen Street Cemetery be designated as having heritage significance under the Ontario Heritage Act part IV because of the significance of the persons interred in the cemetery to the nineteenth century history of Sault Ste. Marie; the integrity of design which the Queen Street Cemetery still retains and the example of a nineteenth century and early twentieth century municipal cemetery in a Northern Ontario community which the Queen Street Cemetery represents.

NOTICE of objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Sault Ste. Marie before the 6th day of June, 1994
