CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE WELLINGTON

BY-LAW NO. 2004 - 058

Being a By-law to Repeal By-Law No. 1881 of the former Village of Elora, which designated the property known as the "Victoria Street Bridge", Victoria Street, Elora, Ontario.

WHEREAS the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18, Section 31 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to repeal designating by-laws; and

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Centre Wellington has caused to be served upon the owners of the structure known as the **Victoria Street Bridge** notice of intention to de-designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality;


AND WHEREAS the reasons for de-designation are set out in Schedule "B" hereto;


AND WHEREAS no notice of objection the said de-designation has been served upon the clerk of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE WELLINGTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That By-law No. 1881, passed by the Corporation of the Village of Elora on the 18th day of July, 1983 to designate the Victoria Street Bridge, Elora, Ontario be repealed.
2. That the Victoria Street Bridge be de-designated under Section 31 of the *Ontario Heritage Act* due to severe deterioration of the subject structure and the imminent danger of collapse.
3. That the Township Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served upon the owners of the aforesaid property and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of this by-law to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the Township of Centre Wellington.
4. This By-law shall come into force and take effect upon its final passing.



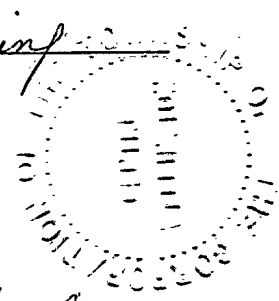

NOTICE OF DE-DESIGNATION

Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Centre Wellington has passed By-law No. 2004-058 de-designating the property known as the Victoria Street Bridge". Victoria Street, Elora, Ontario.

REASONS FOR DE-DESIGNATION

1. To permit the complete removal of the Victoria Street Bridge due to the rapidly deteriorating condition of the bridge, the imminent danger of collapse and the potential danger to safety of the public.
2. The repair of the bridge would involve the replacement of the majority of the original elements of the bridge.
3. The pony trusses are beyond repair or replacement within reasonable economic limitations.

The Victoria Street Bridge structure is located within the Township of Centre Wellington (formerly the Village of Elora) on the Victoria Street road allowance crossing the Grand River south of West Mill Street and north of Ross Street, as shown on Registered Plan 181, now in the Township of Centre Wellington.

**Statement of Reasons for the De-Designation
of the Victoria Street Bridge, Elora, Ontario**

The reasons for de-designation are:

1. To permit the complete removal of the Victoria Street Bridge due to the rapidly deteriorating condition of the bridge, the imminent danger of collapse and the potential danger to safety of the public.
2. The repair of the bridge would involve the replacement of the majority of the original elements of the bridge.
3. The pony trusses are beyond repair or replacement within reasonable economic limitations.
