## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, on the 1st day of October, 1975, decided to designate the lands and buildings, known municipally as 1179 King Street West, as a property of historical and architectural value or interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122.

## Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The Toronto Carpet Manufacturing Co., 1179 King Stret West at Fraser Avenue.

The Toronto Carpet Manufacturing Company is important in architectural and historical terms as a well-preserved example of a late nineteenth century industrial complex. Its size and design (with a corner clock tower) is such that it is also a landmark and a dominant element in the area's streetscape.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of October 10th, 1975.
