THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ALNWICK

BY-LAW NUMBER 26-91

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS THE "ROSENEATH AGRICULTURE SOCIETY'S CAROUSEL BUILDING", located in part lot 16, concession 2, Township of Alnwick and more particularly described on attached-- plan 39R-3627, as being of Architectural and historic value of interest, and

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Alnwick has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as the Roseneath Agriculture Society, Roseneath, Ontario, part lot 16, concession 2, Township of Alnwick and upon the Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks and the Roseneath Agriculture Society's carousel building is recommended for designation under the Ontario Heritage Act for its' historical and architectural significance, Historically, this building houses the Roseneath Agriculture Society's carousel or merry-go-round and has been a focal point of the Roseneath Fair for over 50 years. Erected in 1932 or soon thereafter, the sixteen sides of this rural depression building lift to give an open air feeling in appropriate weather. Each of the sixteen ribs is a cranked frame which sits on a perimeter concrete base and meets the other fifteen ribs in a circle above the centre of the carousel. The roofing is of profiled steel sheet whilst the walls are of vertical timber boarding. The top half of each section of wall is hinged so that it can open out to permit the carousel to be seen and the riders to see out.

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the clerk of the municipality,

THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Alnwick enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being architectural and historical value of interest the real property known as the carousel building on the Roseneath Fair Grounds, Township of Alnwick and more particularly described according to the schedule of Plan 39R-3627;

Firstly: Part 1, Plan 39R-3627, being part of locations 66 and 67, Registered Plan Number 45;

Secondly: Part 2, Plan 39R-3627, being part of lot 14, Registered Plan 40, part of location 66, Registered Plan # 45.

Plan 39R-3627 is marked Schedule "A" and is attached hereto and forms part of this by-law.

2. The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in the Schedule "A", hereto, in the proper lands registry office.
3. The clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once each of the three consecutive weeks.

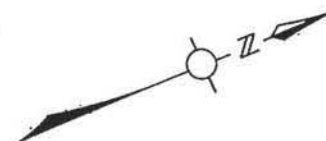
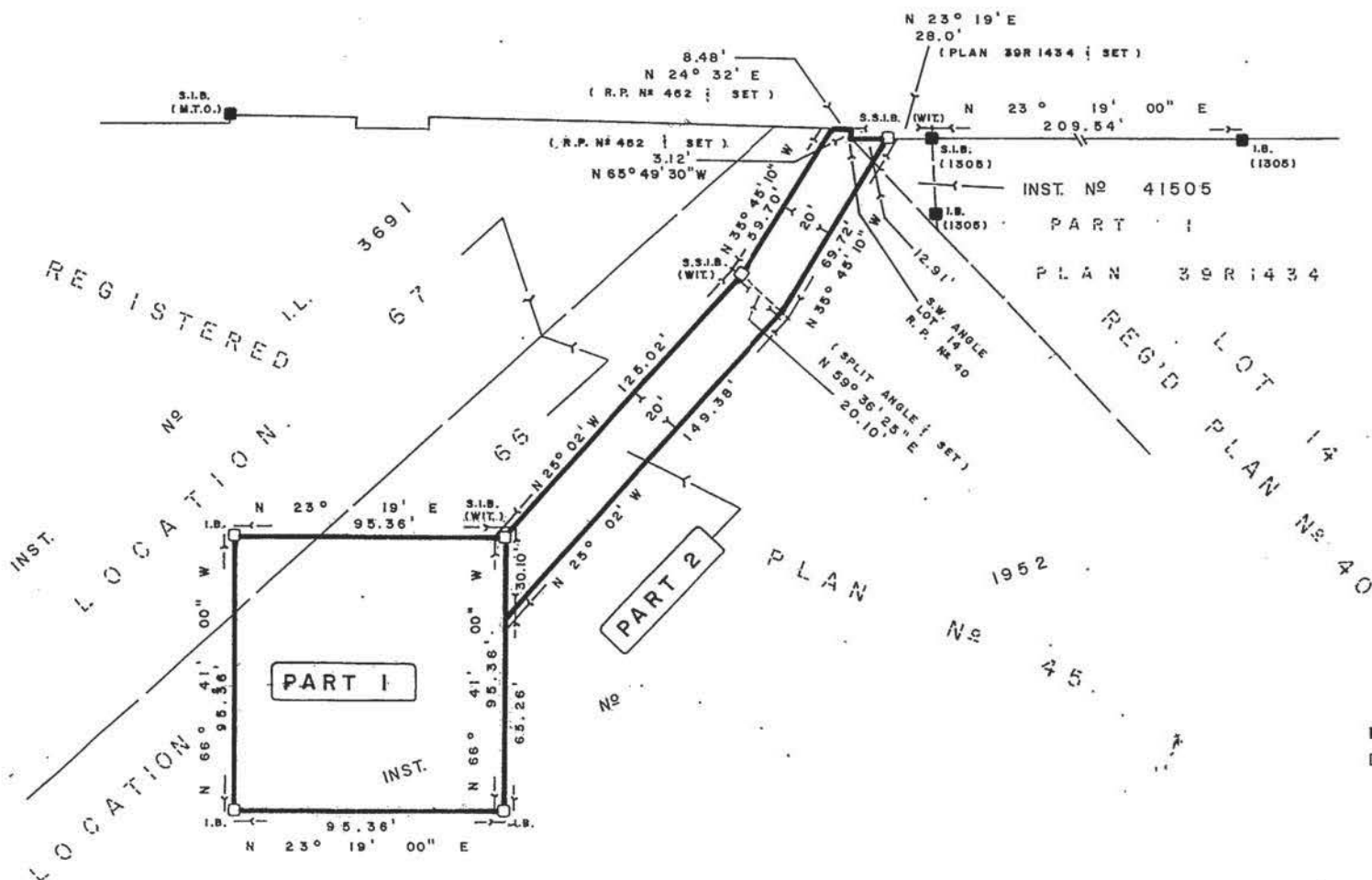
