THE CORPORATION OF THE
BOROUGH OF SCARBOROUGH
BY-LAW NUMBER 19127

to designate Centennial United Church at 6550 Kingston Road as being of historical and architectural value.

WHEREAS the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate a real property, including all the buildings and structures thereon, to be of historic or architectural value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Borough of Scarborough has caused to be served upon the owners of the lands and premises known as "Centennial United Church" at 6550 Kingston Road and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in a newspaper having a general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS the reasons for designation are set out in Schedule "B" hereto; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the said proposed designation has been served upon the Clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE BOROUGH OF SCARBOROUGH ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. There is designated as being of architectural value or interest the real property more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto, known as "Centennial United Church" at 6550 Kingston Road.
2. The Borough Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper land registry office.
3. The Borough Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served upon the owner of the aforesaid property and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of this by-law to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the Borough of Scarborough.

SCHEDULE "A" - By-law 19127

HERITAGE ACT - CENTENNIAL UNITED CHURCH

DESCRIPTION OF LAND

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate lying and being in the Borough of Scarborough in the Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto and being composed of that part of Lot 3 in the First Concession of the said Borough designated as PART 1 on a reference plan deposited in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Toronto Boroughs and York South as Plan 64R-8530.

SCHEDULE "B" - By-law 19127

Reasons for the designation of "Centennial United Church"
at 6550 Kingston Road.

This church is recommended for designation for both historical and architectural reasons. It is of historical interest as the 1891 successor of two mid-nineteenth century Methodist churches in the Highland Creek area. A small plain brick building, it is typical of the simple Canadian gothic church architecture of later Victorian times common in rural communities.
