

Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto has passed By-law No. 154-85, repealing By-law No. 114-76 which designated the above property.

No. 154-85. A BY-LAW

To repeal By-law No. 114-76 respecting the designation of the Metallic Roofing Company of Canada building at 1190-1192 King Street West of architectural value.

(Passed February 11, 1985.)

Whereas pursuant to clause (b) of subsection 32(2) of the Ontario Heritage Act the Council of The Corporation of the City of Toronto at its meeting held on the 11th day of February, 1985, has consented to the application of the owner of the property known municipally as 1190-1192 King Street West to pass a by-law repealing By-law No. 114-76 designating the aforesaid property.

Therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Toronto enacts as follows:

- 1. By-law No. 114-76, being "A By-law To designate the Metallic Roofing Company of Canada building at 1190-1192 King Street West of architectural value" is hereby repealed.
- 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of this by-law to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Toronto and to delete reference to the aforesaid property from the Register referred to in subsection 27(1) of the Ontario Heritage Act.
- 3. The City Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper land registry office.
