
Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, on the 12th day of April, 1977, decided to designate the lands and buildings, known municipally as No.449 Jarvis Street, as a property of architectural value or interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, 1974 S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The house at 449 Jarvis Street (The Celebrity Club) is recommended for designation for architectural reasons in context with adjacent houses. Built in 1892 for Edward F. Blake, it represents fine craftsmanship in ornamentation and in the Gothic revival detailing of the gables and parapets. It is a unique example of architectural form from the period.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of the 22nd day of April, 1977. (File 1287).
