## RE: Repeal of By-law 2002-123, Designation of 111 Victoria Street, Welland

In accordance with the requirements of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, please be advised that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Welland intends to repeal By-law 2002-123 which designated 111 Victoria Street in the City of Welland, known as the "Vaughan Seed Company" of historic or architectural value or interest on July 16, 2002 under Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18.

The Vaughan Seed Company building was razed by fire on June 8, 2008. Provincial guidelines regarding heritage properties that are demolished outline that council must repeal the designation By-law in question to provide accurate records regarding the legal title of the affected property. This also ensures that municipal and provincial registers of heritage properties are accurate and up to date.

Notice of objection to the repealing By-law may be filed with the City Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Welland no later than the 28th day of July, 2014.
