Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, on the 23rd day of July, 1979, having considered the application for Consent to Demolish the buildings erected on the property known municipally as No. 287 King Street East, and after giving consideration to the matter, decided:

TO REFUSE THE APPLICATION TO DEMOLISH UNDER SECTION 34 OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, 1974 AND PROHIBIT ANY WORK TO DEMOLISH OR REMOVE ANY BUILDING OR STRUCTURE ON THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS NO. 287 KING STREET EAST FOR A PERIOD OF ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY (180) DAYS FROM THE 23RD DAY OF JULY, 1979.
