Reasons for Proposed Designation:

The existing Milton Town Hall at 251 Main Street East, is an example of classic Georgian architecture.

The building was officially opened in 1865 with the First Town Council Meeting in the building taking place on September 16th, 1867.

Notice of Objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Town of Milton before the 18th day of January, 1985.
